## Tips for using the "Personal Bible Study Question Prompts":

- 1. **THE Biggest Tip is this: BE WILLING TO BE WRONG.** Submit your ideals, your beliefs, your understanding, & your logic to be changed by an All-Knowing, All-Wise, Almighty God. If what you believe differs from His Word, you are, by default, wrong. Be willing to accept that fact & be willing to surrender in prayer for God to change your mind to trust Him above all else, even above yourself.
- 2. **Keep in PRAYER as you read.** Let God lead your understanding of HIS Word.
- 3. For more information on how to better study your Bible, I highly recommend training from my friend Katie Orr over at her website: www.katieorr.me Her passion is teaching women HOW to study the Bible in quick, easy, building-block steps. She breaks down tools you can put in your Bible Study toolbelt to help enrich your time in God's Word. Some of the question prompts in my guide were concepts I learned from her & she does a better job at it than I. Please check her out if diving deeper into God's Word interests you! Her training even comes with a community of women seeking the same thing & encouraging each other along the way!
- 4. These Question Prompts can be printed double-sided or on separate pages, depending on your preference—<u>but make sure to select pages 2-3 in the printer settings, if printing a lot of copies.</u>
- 5. **Consider printing several copies** & hole-punching them, putting them in a binder. (You can even add dividers in that binder for each book of the Bible or by topic.)
- 6. OR, print 1 copy & keep it tucked in a journal you're already using, as a guide!
- 7. Strong's Concordance APP is a useful resource for studying your Bible, as well as BibleHub.com, using the "Strong's" tab. These tools allow you to look up the original Greek & Hebrew words, as well as other places in the Bible where they are used & how they are translated in those different passages, offering a possibly richer understanding of the text.
